Introduction



- This research was funded by the *Musashino University Creating Happiness Incubation*.
- It was carried out by a team of four professionals from social work, psychology, early childhood education and care, and nursing.
- Since 2018, a 'parenting forum' for parents (especially mothers) of children with disabilities has been held on the university campus on a trial basis.
- The difficulties of parenting in Japan and the finding that mothers with disabled children need opportunities to chat with peers and be liberated are reported at the 2019 OMEP Kyoto conference.

A place to talk about "nurture x happiness"

- In this social situation where connections between people seem to be weakening, people need to have time to talk about themselves with someone
- For mothers (women) involved in child-rearing to overcome difficulties and isolation in various aspects of their lives
- A website and online salon(forum) for meeting on the screen in between household chores and works
- For keeping them connected with their peer
- For planting seeds of child-rearing support activities in various regions



The online forum "Yururi"



A place to freely chat about everyday experiences, thoughts, and questions centered on pregnancy, childbirth, and parenting.





「ゆるりゆらり」の居心地はいかがでしたか?あてはまるもの1つに〇をつけて下さい。 16件の回答





1. Ease of Participation

- Being able to participate from the comfort of their own home, as long as they can find the right time.
- The age of the children and the work situation of the participants vary.
- The date and time need to be devised.
- So far, it seems to be easier to participate during the daytime or in the evening on weekdays.



2. Meeting Strangers



- There was a need to share information with people who do not see each other in everyday life.
- It is sometimes difficult to talk with people from the same school or area.
- Confirmation should be needed at the point of application

3. Thema talk vs Free talk

- The group was basically run in a way that participants talk freely
- When the topic was different from what a participant want to talk \rightarrow "I wanted to talk about $\bigcirc\bigcirc$, but not today • "
- Setting a theme for recruiting participants may needed



4. Application procedure and limitation

[Application]

- 1. receiving a registration email
- 2. delivering the research consent form and login URL

[Difficulties]

- Last-minute responses are difficult
- Could give the information to someone not applied

[Number of participants]

- Smaller numbers are easier to talk to on screen
- Need to set a maximum number of participants to automatically complete the registration process



5. Need for Meeting in Person & Outreach

[ONLINE]

- Difficult to form non-verbal relationships
- The sense of 'sharing a place' is not experienced
- Only one person speaking at a time
- Same time interruption is unable
- Local child rearing forums (in person) is restricted due to strict infection control measures
- Talking face to face is demanded




Future initiatives
